

Anoka-Ramsey Community College Spring 2022 Final Enrollment Report

Enrollment Headcounts

Core enrollment includes all students who attend at least one course on-campus at ARCC (including PSEO students). Concurrent enrollment includes all students who attend undergraduate-level credit courses offered at area high schools (through ARCC) under the provisions of the Post Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) program. Total enrollment includes all students who attend ARCC. Headcount is the unduplicated count of students registered for at least one credit during this term (i.e. students are counted only once even if they are enrolled in multiple courses). Credits are the total number of credits students have registered for at ARCC (or at the individual campus). FTE is full-time equivalent enrollment which is calculated by dividing the number of credits by 15.

Student Status

A full-time student is a student who is registered for 12 or more credits. A part-time student is a student who is registered for fewer than 12 credits. For each campus, the data reflects the number and percentage of students who are registered for 12 or more credits total (not necessarily all at that particular campus). A new student is a student who has not previously attended the institution. For fall semester, "new" students include anyone who is enrolled for credit during fall term but whose first term of enrollment at the institution was the summer term immediately preceding the fall term. A continuing student is a student who previously attended the institution. However, PSEO (and other high school students) who re-enroll at the institution as regular undergraduates after graduating from high school are considered "new" students. Headcount is the unduplicated count of students in each category.

FTE is the count of credits taken by PSEO students divided by 15.
