

Practical Nursing Clinical Immunization Requirements

The requirements listed below **MUST** be met in order to attend clinical settings at Anoka Technical College.

CPR card: CPR card **must** be current. Check the renewal date on your CPR cards. Failure to renew CPR certification will result in being unable to attend clinical until CPR is brought up to date.

CPR courses that meet the requirement: American Heart Association BLS Healthcare Provider, American Red Cross CPR for Professional Rescuers, or HBEM 2020 CPR for Healthcare Providers, or current First Responders. Online certification courses do not meet this requirement.

Completed Student Record of Immunization form:

This form needs to be completed by a health care provider. It will need to be turned in to your advisor by a specific date in semester two. The following immunizations are required for clinical participation.

MMR: Measles, Mumps, and Rubella.

Measles: 2 doses after age 12 months

Mumps: 2 doses after age 12 months

Rubella: 2 doses after age 12 months

OR

Positive serology report of immunity for rubeola and rubella and mumps

Hepatitis B vaccine series

3 doses or proof of immunity by serology report

At least 2 doses of the Hepatitis B series must be completed in semester one of the program.

Background study: We need to receive a background study stating that you may administer direct patient care.

Negative Mantoux: You will need to obtain a Mantoux one week prior to clinical. If you have had a positive Mantoux skin test in the past, you will need to submit a copy of a negative chest x-ray report that is dated within two years of beginning coursework in semester four. A symptom questionnaire will also need to be completed prior to starting the clinical experiences in Semester three. You must submit this documentation on the first day of clinical orientation.
