Program Description

The Litigation Specialist program prepares the student to work in litigation specialties such as personal injury, workers' compensation, and marriage dissolution. Many law firms specialize in these areas of law.

Since full-time students usually take 15 credits per semester or more, it would be possible for a student who already has high keyboarding skills and a strong computer background to complete the program in one year. Students without these basic skills must complete skill development courses before enrolling in the legal specialty courses.
