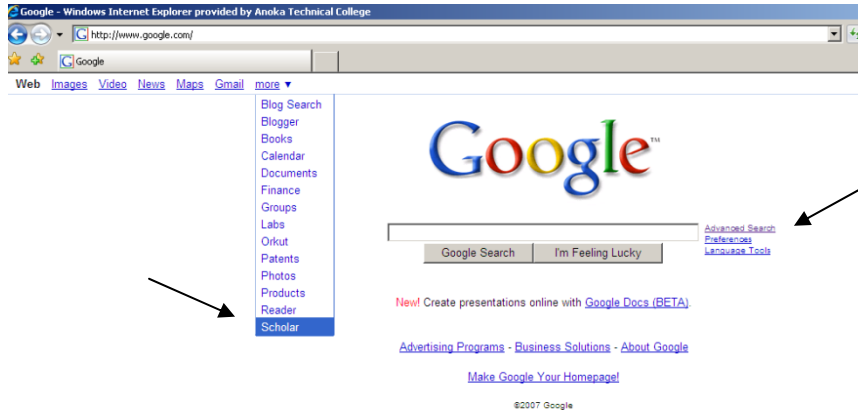


How to search Google Scholar

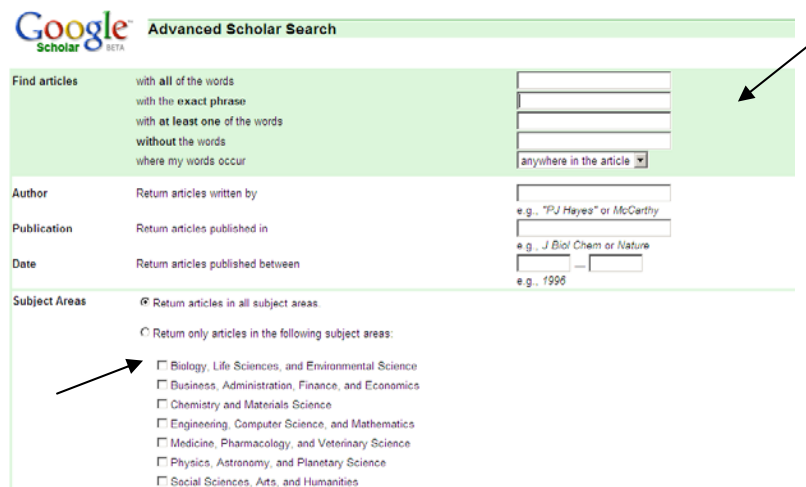
Choose "Scholar" from the "More" options at www.google.com



Click on Advanced Search.

To search for an exact article, type the article name in the exact phrase search rectangle.

If you are not searching for a known article, but using Google Scholar for a keyword query, the "Subject Areas" predefined limits at the bottom of the advanced search screen are helpful.



The results may be "grouped" in an effort to organize the results page. To the right of the results it will say "all X versions". Click on "all X versions" for the grouping that closest matches the information need. View each document within the grouping one by one to determine if there is a FREE copy, preferably a PDF version, available online.
