**Description:** The Operations Supervisor is a front line manager who dispatches Train and Engineering movements on the railroad in a safe and efficient manner.

### **Specific Responsibilities:**

- Issues necessary Track authorities to safely move trains across the railroad.
- Issues necessary Track authorities for the protection of Engineering personnel.
- Records information as required by the railroad and the Federal Government.
- Issues necessary Track Bulletins and Track Condition Messages to protect trains and Engineering personnel.
- Stays informed of weather conditions over the railroad and takes action when adverse conditions exist to provide a safe train operation environment.
- Informs Operations Manager of overall operations of trains and any delays.
- Provides for the prompt movement of cars when billed, reporting any delayed car movement to the Operations Manager.
- Assists in the investigation of train accidents and personal injuries, when required.
- Nexus system updates as required.
- Complies with requirements of Transportation Health and Safety Plan.

### **Qualifications:**

- High School Graduate or equivalent work experience.
- One to three (1 to 3) years experience in Transportation or Train Operations.
- Previous Train Dispatcher or comparable experience.
- Thorough knowledge of General Code of Operating Rules, Timetables, Operations Supervisor Manuals, and Notices including passing of required exams.
- Must be familiar with train operations and associated rules.
- Must understand physical characteristics of the railroad.
- Must have knowledge of various types of locomotive power.
- Must possess ability to analyze rapidly and be capable of making quick decisions.
- Must be computer literate and have experience with computerized train control applications.
- Requires shift work as assigned, including nights, weekends and holidays.
