Accuplacer Retesting

Test scores are used to determine course placement. Your scores will indicate whether you begin your college studies by registering for college-level or developmental courses.

- College-level course - A college-level course is a college or university course that meets college-level standards. Credits earned in a college-level course apply toward the requirements of a certificate, diploma, or degree.
- Developmental course - A developmental course is a course designed to prepare a student for entry into college-level courses. Developmental course credits do not apply toward a certificate, diploma, or degree.

When placements are below college-level

OPTION 1 - Review with ABE, then retest

- Students may retest only once within a two year period.
- Students no longer in high school are required to begin review by attending ABE Orientation.
- Bring your Accuplacer test scores. You will need them to attend.
- Time necessary for review is determined by several factors. ABE teachers will help you prepare as quickly as possible.
- The ABE teacher will determine when you are ready to retest, and provide you an Authorization to Retest form. You may not retest without it.
- High school students wishing to retest are required to follow the alternate procedure provided by the Test Administrator.

Retest fee, retest appointment

A retest fee of \$10 per retest session is payable at the Business office window.

- 00 - 61 READ 0900 Reading Skills (Dev.), recommended to Adult Basic Education
- 62 - 77 READ 0900 Reading Skills (Dev.)
- 78 - 120 Reading at college level, no further reading comprehension courses required

WRITING

*college-level course placement based on
both Reading Comprehension and Sentence Skills test scores*

Sentence Skills

- 00 - 60 ENGL 0101 Basic English (Dev.), recommended to Adult Basic Education
- 61 - 85 ENGL 0101 Basic English (Dev.)
- 86 - 120 ENGL 1105 Composition I ONLY if Reading Comprehension score is 78 or greater

MATH

based on Arithmetic test score

- 00 - 29 Recommended to Adult Basic Education
- 30 - 70 MATH 0801 Basic Math (Dev.)
- 71 - 120 MATH 1050 Technical Math
 - MATH 1060 Applied Math for Statics and Strength of Materials

- 81 - 120 MATH 1010 Dosage Calculations for Health Professionals

Elementary Algebra

- 00 - 75 MATH 0900 Elementary and Intermediate Algebra (Dev.)
- 76 - 120 Place into CLM course ONLY if CLM score is 50 or greater

College-level Math

- 00 - 49 MATH 0950 Topics in Intermediate Algebra (Dev.)
- 50 - 120 MATH 1500 Mathematical Ideas ONLY if EL ALG score is 76 or greater
 - MATH 1550 Introduction to Statistics ONLY if EL ALG score is 76 or greater
 - MATH 1600 College Algebra ONLY if EL ALG score is 76 or greater
 - MATH 1650 College Trigonometry ONLY if EL ALG score is 76 or greater
 - MATH 1700 Pre-Calculus ONLY if EL ALG score is 76 or greater
