Clinical Immunization Requirements



The requirements listed below MUST be met in order to attend clinicals at Anoka Tech.

CPR card: CPR card **must** be current.

Failure to renew CPR certification will result in being unable to attend clinical until CPR is brought up to date.

Check the renewal date on your CPR cards.

MMR (measles, mumps and rubella)

Proof of documentation of:

MMR vaccine x2 after 1967 OR

MMR vaccine x1 within the last 5 years OR

Positive serology of immunity for rubeola and rubella and mumps

Hepatitis B

Proof of documentation of:

Hepatitis B vaccine x3 or have begun the series of three vaccines OR

Positive serology of immunity for Hepatitis B

Chickenpox/varicella

Self-signed health form indicating past history of chicken pox with the approximate date
OR

Documentation of the series of two vaccines OR

Positive serology of immunity to chickenpox

Background study: We need to receive a background study stating that you may administer direct patient care.

Negative Mantoux: You will need to obtain a Mantoux one week prior to clinical. You must submit proof of the Mantoux on the first day of clinical orientation

OR submit a negative chest x-ray report and a completed symptom questionnaire.
