

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AND APPROVAL POLICY



New program and course proposals and programmatic and course changes are always made carefully and thoughtfully with attention paid to the needs of the particular industry served by the program, to the college mission and to the inclusion of general education courses and concepts into program curricula.

Each year faculty review their curriculum and programs to determine industry and student needs. Faculty utilizes input from advisory committees, environmental scans and other pertinent data relevant to their programs. During fall semester of each year faculty review their programs and courses, discuss changes with their advisory committee members and administration and bring any appropriate program and course changes and new program proposals to the Academic Affairs and Standards Council (AASC). Approved changes and new program proposals and courses are then included in the next published college catalog.
