Enrollment Headcounts

Headcount is an unduplicated headcount of students registered for at least one credit during this term (i.e., students are counted only once, even if they are enrolled in multiple courses). Credits are the total number of credits students have registered for at ATC (or at the individual campus). FTE is full-time equivalent enrollment, which is based on 15 credits per semester (total eligible credits /15).
